PREFACE

This specification, prepared by Committee EL/2, Electrical Approvals Standards, was approved on behalf of the Council of the Standards Association of Australia on 25 February 1980, and was published on 1 May 1980.

It is one of a series of approval and test specifications issued by the Association under Part 2 of the SAA Wiring Rules. These specifications are accompanied by a general specification AS C100, containing definitions and general requirements for electrical materials and equipment. The purpose of these specifications is to outline conditions which must be met to secure approval for the sale and use of electrical equipment in Australia. Only safety matters and related conditions are covered.

This edition was published to incorporate into the specification the five amendments to AS 3162—1971 and to effect changes to Table 1 in regard to the tests required.

This specification supersedes AS 3162—1971 from the date of publication.

The Association desires to call attention to the fact that this specification does not purport to include all the necessary conditions of a contract.

This specification shall be read in conjunction with AS 3162 (See also Clause 3, below.)

1 SCOPE. This specification applies to electric food preparation appliances, as defined in Clause 2.1 below, which are intended primarily for household use and designed for operation at 240 V a.c.

2 DEFINITIONS. For the purpose of this specification the following definitions shall apply:

2.1 Electric food preparation appliance—an electrical appliance which is designed for use in the preparation of solid or liquid food by mixing, beating, blending, mincing, grinding, slicing, extraction or separation of juice, or other similar processes. It may be designed for one particular function or, by the use of various attachments, for a number of separate functions. For the purpose of this specification an electric can opener shall be regarded as a food preparation appliance.

NOTE: Throughout the specification an electric food preparation appliance is referred to as a food preparation appliance.

2.2 Food mixer—a food preparation appliance designed primarily for mixing foods by the operation of beaters or the like. This does not include blending mixers as defined in Clause 2.3 below.

2.3 Blending mixer (blender, emulsifier or liquidizer)—a food preparation appliance of a type intended to reduce a combination of vegetables, fruit, butter, eggs or similar solid foods together with a liquid, to a blend of the two.

2.4 Coffee grinder—a food preparation appliance designed to grind or break up roasted coffee beans into small particles. This may be achieved by means of rotating discs, cylinders, cones or high-speed cutting blades.

2.5 Juice extractor—a food preparation appliance designed primarily to remove juice from citrus fruits by means of a rotating reamer, pressure normally being applied to the fruit by hand.
