## PREFACE

This Standard was prepared by the Standards Australia Committee ME-033, Abrasives, to supersede, AS/NZS 4528:1998, *Coated abrasives—General purpose rolls—Any backing—Designation and dimensions*, AS/NZS 4529:1998, *Coated abrasives—Rolls for widths of 50 mm and greater—Any backing—Designation and dimensions* and AS/NZS 4530:1998, *Coated abrasives—Cloth rolls up to and including 40 mm width—Designation and dimensions*.

This Standard is identical with, and has been reproduced from ISO 3366:1999, *Coated abrasives—Abrasive rolls*.

The objective of this Standard is to provide manufacturers and users of coated abrasive products with dimensions and their designation for general purpose rolls of coated abrasives.

The objective of this revision is to adopt the current ISO Standard on this topic.

As this Standard is reproduced from an international Standard, the following apply:

- (a) Its number appears on the cover and title page while the International Standard number appears only on the cover.
- (b) In the source test, 'this International Standard' should read 'this Australian Standard'.
- (c) A full point substitutes for a comma when referring to a decimal marker.

References to international Standards should be replaced by equivalent Australian, New Zealand or Australian/New Zealand Standards, as follows:
