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## PREFACE

This Standard was prepared by the Australian members of the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee IT-012, Information systems—Security and identification technology. After consultation with stakeholders in both countries, Standards Australia and Standards New Zealand decided to develop this Standard as an Australian, rather than an Australian/New Zealand Standard.

This Standard is identical with, and has been reproduced from ISO/IEC 15292:2001, *Information technology—Security techniques—Protection Profile registration procedures*.

The objective of this Standard is to define the procedures to be applied by the JTC 1 Registration Authority appointed by the ISO and IEC councils to maintain a register of Protection Profiles and packages for the purposes of IT security evaluation.

The term ‘informative’ has been used in this Standard to define the application of the appendix to which it applies. An ‘informative’ appendix is only for information and guidance.

As this Standard is reproduced from an international standard, the following apply:

- Its number appears on the cover and title page while the international standard number appears only on the cover.
- In the source text ‘this International Standard’ should read ‘this Australian Standard’.
- A full point substitutes for a comma when referring to a decimal marker.

References to International Standards should be replaced by references to Australian or Australian/New Zealand Standards, as follows:

# Information technology — Security techniques — Protection Profile registration procedures

## 1 Scope

This International Standard defines the procedures to be applied by the JTC 1 Registration Authority, appointed by the ISO and IEC councils to maintain a register of Protection Profiles and packages for the purposes of IT security evaluation. These Protection Profiles and packages are specified in accordance with criteria given in ISO/IEC 15408.
