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Preface

This is the first edition of the CSA F378 Series, *Solar collectors*, which is comprised of F378.1, *Glazed and unglazed liquid heating solar collectors — Test methods* and F378.2, *Air heating solar collectors — Test methods*. It replaces the previous edition of CSA F378, *Solar Collectors*, published in 1987.

This Series was developed in response to the need for an updated document that sets nationally recognized technical requirements covering both liquid heating and air heating solar collectors. Significant advances have been made in solar collector technology since the publication of CSA F378 in 1987.

CSA hereby recognizes the technical assistance provided by WP4.1 of the New Generation of Solar Thermal System (NEGST) project, and in particular Josef Buchinger, who compiled the seed document that guided committee members during the development of the CSA F378 Series.
