0 Introduction

0.1 General

This Standard addresses an organization's need to select and provide appropriate fall protection training for workers' safety, linked to the needs assessment (see Clause [4.2](#)) and based on the information contained in CSA Z259.17.

The goal of fall protection training is to assist workers, supervisors, and employers in developing and gaining the skills and knowledge to perform their work in a manner that reduces the risk of harm relating to working at heights and fall hazard exposures.

It is important that training be designed by individuals with appropriate qualifications and subject matter expertise, and that delivery of training be done in a way that is safe and conducive to learning. The training provider can be a competent person from the organization, or it can be a competent third-party organization that provides training in accordance with this Standard.

0.2 Stakeholders

Various stakeholders can be involved, including

- a) workers;
- b) organizations that employ workers to carry out such work;
- c) individuals responsible for ensuring that the organization's workers are qualified to carry out such work;
- d) organizations or individuals (entities) who design training for fall protection matters; and
- e) entities who deliver fall protection training for an organization.

It should be noted that throughout this Standard, the terms "organization" and "employer" may be considered interchangeable, and the same applies to "worker" and "trainee".

1 Scope

1.1 General

This Standard specifies the requirements for and provides guidance on fall protection training in the workplace.

1.2 Purpose

The purpose of this Standard is to provide guidance to organizations and training providers on practices for fall protection training in accordance with this Standard, and applicable legislation.

1.3 Application

This Standard is applicable to organizations of any size or type, and to organizations and individuals who design, develop, and deliver fall protection training.
