2.1 Relationship to Regulatory Guidance Material

The list of operational hazard severity classifications and the list of candidate operational safety and performance requirements that are contained in this document were developed in accordance with RTCA DO 264. These hazard severity classifications do not take into consideration efforts by regulatory authorities to address conservative equipment reliability standards for certain classes of aircraft and their overall relationship to safety.
